A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Chapter 1 of Title 51 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 general provisions relative to torts, so as to revise the Good Samaritan law to provide for
- 3 damaging property in emergency situations; to amend Code Section 16-3-20 of the Official
- 4 Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to justification, so as to cross-reference the Good
- 5 Samaritan law; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other
- 6 purposes.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

8 SECTION 1.

- 9 Chapter 1 of Title 51 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to general
- provisions relative to torts, is amended by revising Code Section 51-1-29, relating to liability
- 11 of persons rendering emergency care, as follows:
- 12 "51-1-29.
- 13 (a) Any person, including any person licensed to practice medicine and surgery pursuant
- to Article 2 of Chapter 34 of Title 43 and including any person licensed to render services
- ancillary thereto, who in good faith renders emergency care at the scene of an accident or
- 16 emergency to the victim or victims thereof without making any charge therefor shall not
- be liable for any civil damages as a result of any act or omission by such person in
- rendering emergency care or as a result of any act or failure to act to provide or arrange for
- 19 further medical treatment or care for the injured person.
- 20 (b) As used in this Code section, the term 'emergency care' shall include, but shall not be
- 21 <u>limited to, the rescue or attempted rescue of an incapacitated or endangered individual from</u>
- 22 <u>a locked motor vehicle."</u>

23 SECTION 2.

- 24 Code Section 16-3-20 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to justification,
- 25 is amended by revising paragraph (5) as follows:

- 26 "(5) When the person's conduct is justified for any other reason under the laws of this
- state, including as provided in Code Section 51-1-29; or"

28 SECTION 3.

29 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
